Abraham Verses 17-25 focus on the birth of Christ. In between the genealogy and Christ's birth we are introduced to Joseph, the husband of Mary and stepfather of Christ. Matthew is the only gospel writer to explain that Joseph wanted to divorce Mary because she was a pregnant virgin. This was something that had never been seen before in all of human history, so The Most High sent Gabriel to assure Joseph that Mary's pregnancy was of The Most High. It is through this story that we get a glimpse of Joseph's character. He did not want to raise a child that wasn't his, but he also wanted to divorce Mary in private so that her reputation would not be ruined.
