INTRODUCTION

The use of mathematical models in sociology is recognized as a subfield of sociology with its own textbooks, journals, sessions at professional meetings, and training programs. It is a vigorous specialty, and there is no longer any doubt that mathematical sociology can be practiced. Though there have been discontinuities, blind alleys, and false promises, there have also been continuities and progress. This essay presents an overview of the field, emphasizing these continuities and the main approaches of mathematical sociology.

Though mathematical sociology has few practitioners, there is no consensus on the delineation of the field. A definition stating that mathematical sociology concerns the application of mathematics to sociological problems is reasonable but probably too diffuse. Statistics is an all-important tool of quantitative sociologists, but the mere practice of statistics for the purposes of estimation and inference would not be considered mathematical sociology by most mathematical sociologists. Similarly the application of ad hoc linear models for the purposes of establishing relationships among variables probably would not be considered mathematical sociology by most. The construction of models implementing a theory about a sociological phenomenon would be considered a central activity of mathematical sociology. It is, however, not the activity that dominates mathematical sociology.
