Monetarism Focus

Monetarism focuses on the importance of controlling the money supply to manage inflation and promote economic stability.

Keynesianism Focus

Keynesianism is an economic theory that emphasises the role of government intervention in the economy to manage aggregate demand and stabilise the business cycle.

Role of Government

Monetarism, on the other hand, believes in a more limited role for the government in the economy and emphasises the control of the money supply by the central bank to influence economic outcomes.

Role of Government

Keynesianism advocates for active government involvement through fiscal policy, such as increasing government spending or cutting taxes during economic downturns to stimulate demand.
