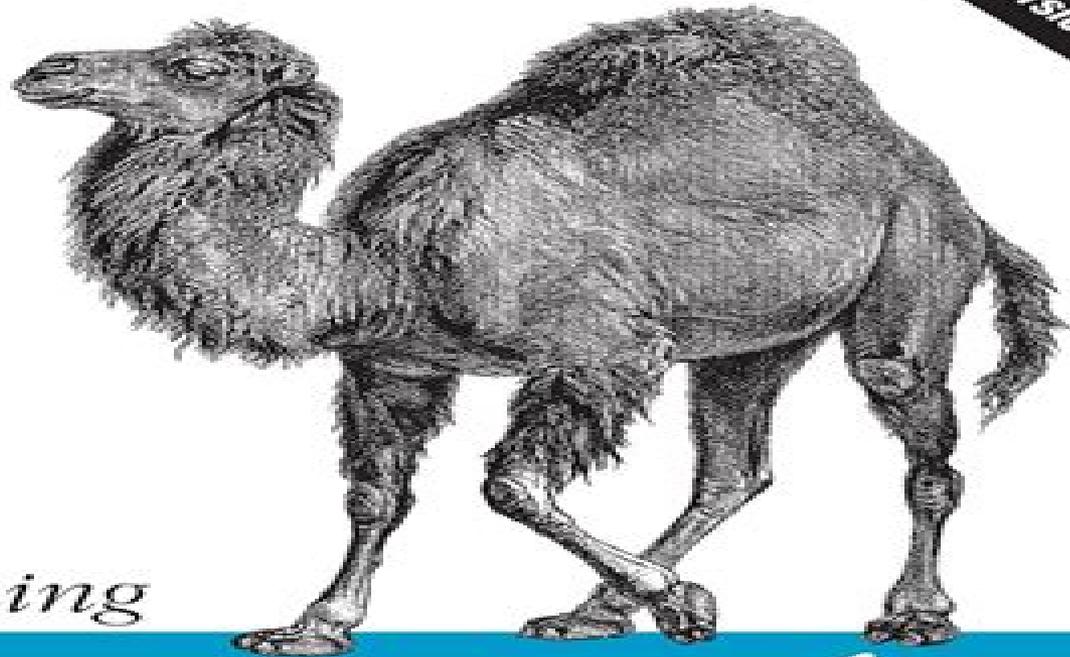

It combines the features of languages like C with shell script's ability to execute large sets of commands. As a result, it was one of the most popular web programming languages out there, even being referred to as the duct tape of the Web.
