

Why Do We Need a Policy for Play?

A play policy provides a framework and guides adults in creating environments and experiences that support children's development through structured and unstructured play. It ensures that play is protected as a key element of children's development. It provides structured guidance for managers, teachers, parents and staff, while promoting self-reflection and evaluation of current practice and support that will be needed.

- 1 Children play should be for fun, enjoyment, self-fulfillment, challenge, problem-solving, social skills and relationships.
- 2 Play should be free for children to allow children to explore, imagine and develop self-identity.

Areas to Think About

- 1 How should a policy define a play and how does it relate to other key areas of the organisation's practice?
- 2 Play activities should be available to children, regardless of their needs, to promote inclusion. Play is a right for all.

Who Should Be Involved in Creating a Play Policy?

Children's learning and play should be at the heart of the setting. Policies, practices, arrangements, resources, activities and staff should all be designed to support and enhance play environments.

Staff teams should be encouraged to contribute to a policy by sharing their expertise, ideas and observations. This will help ensure the policy supports development and inclusion and reflects the needs and interests of the children.

Parents/carers working together should be a shared understanding and collaborative approach. This is particularly important for play or challenging play which can cause concern. Engaging families to discuss and help address their concerns, allowing them to articulate the developmental benefits of play while ensuring appropriate safeguarding is in place.

What is a Play Policy?

A play policy is a legal and essential tool of the parent or guardian that outlines a setting's commitment to promoting and supporting children's play, as well as identifying and addressing their individual current needs.

What Should a Strong Play Policy Include?

Elements of a play policy will be related to your setting and children's needs, however, it should also contain the following:

Reference of the Policy
Provide a clear statement of the intention of play.

Goals
What are your overall goals for play and how will you measure them?

Role of the Staff
What role will staff have in supporting play?

Resources
How will you ensure children have a range of opportunities for play available?

Organisation
How will you ensure children have a range of opportunities for play available?

Environment
What are the conditions of our play environment and how do we ensure it's safe?

Review
How will you ensure the policy is regularly reviewed and updated?

Resources
How will you ensure the resources and materials are available and support play?
