Mississippi River before heading west to join Orion in Nevada He referred humorously to his lack of success at mining turning to journalism for the Virginia City Territorial Enterprise His humorous story The Celebrated Jumping Frog of Calaveras County was published in 1865 based on a story that he heard at Angels Hotel in Angels Camp California where he had spent some time as a miner The short story brought international attention and was even translated into French His wit and satire in prose and in speech earned praise from critics and peers and he was a friend to presidents artists industrialists and European royalty Twain earned a great deal of money from his writings and lectures but he invested in ventures that lost most of it notably the Paige Compositor a mechanical typesetter that failed because of its complexity and imprecision He filed for bankruptcy in the wake of these financial setbacks but he eventually overcame his financial troubles with the help of Henry Huttleston Rogers He chose to pay all his pre bankruptcy creditors in full even after he had no legal responsibility to do so Twain was born shortly after an appearance of Halley s Comet and he predicted that he would go out with it as well he died the day after the comet returned
