

Defining Symptoms of Posttraumatic Stress Disorder

- A.** Exposure to actual or threatened death, serious injury, or sexual violence, in one or more of the following ways: experiencing the event personally, witnessing the event in person, learning that a violent or accidental death or threat of death occurred to a close other, or experiencing repeated or extreme exposure to aversive details of the event(s) other than through the media
- B.** At least one of the following recurrent **intrusion** symptoms:
- Intrusive distressing memories of the trauma(s) or, in children, repetitive play regarding the trauma themes
 - Distressing dreams related to the event(s)
 - Dissociative reactions (e.g., flashbacks) in which the individual feels or acts as if the trauma(s) were recurring or, in children, reenactment of trauma during play
 - Intense or prolonged distress or physiological reactivity in response to reminders of the trauma(s)
- C.** At least one of the following **avoidance** symptoms:
- Avoids internal reminders of the trauma(s)
 - Avoids external reminders of the trauma(s)
- D.** At least two of the following persistent **negative alterations in cognitions and mood** began after the event:
- Inability to remember an important aspect of the trauma(s)
 - Exaggerated negative beliefs or expectations about one's self, others, or the world
 - Excessive blame of self or others about the trauma(s)
 - Negative emotional state or, in children younger than 7, more frequent negative emotions
 - Markedly diminished interest or participation in significant activities
 - Feeling of detachment or estrangement from others or, in children younger than 7, social withdrawal
 - Inability to experience positive emotions
- E.** At least two of the following recurrent changes in **arousal and reactivity**:
- Irritable or aggressive behavior
 - Reckless or self-destructive behavior
 - Hypervigilance
 - Exaggerated startle response
 - Poor concentration
 - Sleep disturbance
- F.** The symptoms began or worsened after the trauma(s) and continued for at least 1 month
- G.** Among children younger than 7, diagnosis requires criteria A, B, E, and F but only one symptom from either category C or category D
